Your Excellency Mr Tony Blair,

Enclosed is a petition from Japanese people and people resident in Japan asking you to abolish British nuclear weapons. The petition is as follows;

Nuclear weapons in your country, as well as those in other nuclear powers, constitute a serious threat to all humans and other living things in the world. We strongly feel the menace all the more because our country actually experienced atomic bombs in Hiroshima and Nagasaki. We the undersigned make an earnest and strong request that you should immediately abandon your current nuclear weapon system "Trident" and not replace it with any other weapon of mass destruction.

This is a second dispatch following the one dated February 21. I have received a letter from Mr M Davies of the Direct Communications Unit, which explained the necessity to keep British WMDs. We circulated it among us and put it on our website, but it was not convincing at all for us. So, many people added their names to our petition. I also enclose a brief letter to Mr Davies responding his reply to our first dispatch.

We sincerely hope that you will understand the will of additional 561 signatories (693 altogether) you see on the papers here enclosed.
